🙀 Day 1: Sydney to Newcastle

Distance: 200 Kms Time: 2 hours 35 minutes

- Morning: Start with breakfast at **The Grounds of Alexandria**, a family favourite known for extravagant seasonal decorations.
- Afternoon: Pick up your motorhome late morning and head to Newcastle. Visit Blackbutt Nature Reserve for an afternoon of wildlife encounters. See koalas, kangaroos, and emus...
- **Evening:** Head to the waterfront for dinner at **Honeysuckle Hotel**, a family-friendly restaurant with scenic views of the harbour. You can easily jump on a **ferry** from Stockton Wharf, saving you driving back!
- Where to stay: NRMA Stockton Beach Holiday Park, 3 Pitt St, Stockton NSW 2295.

Day 2: Newcastle to Port Stephens

Distance: 53.9 Kms Time: 1 hour

 Morning: Start your morning with a trip to Newcastle Beach for a quick surf lesson or beach playtime. Making this a fun introduction to Australia's surf culture!

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- Afternoon: Head to Nelson Bay for a dolphinwatching cruise, which is a must-do in this area. The calm waters of Port Stephens are home to many playful bottlenose dolphins.
- **Evening:** Prepare a delicious home-cooked dinner in the fully equipped kitchen of your Cruisin' Motorhome, then enjoy a quiet and relaxing night at your campsite.
- Where to stay: BIG4 Bays Holiday Park, 23 Port Stephens Dr, Anna Bay NSW 2316.

Day 3: Port Stephens to Forster

Distance: 162 Kms Time: 1 hour 53 minutes

 the dunes are the largest in the Southern Hemisphere, and kids will love sliding down the sandy slopes!
- Afternoon: Drive to Forster along The Lakes Way, a scenic coastal drive with stunning views of lush forests and sparkling lakes.
- Evening: Settle in your campsite, then walk to Beach Bums Café for a nice dinner by the beach. Known for its casual dining and beachy atmosphere, it's a relaxed spot to watch the sunset.
- Where to stay: Reflections Forster Beach Holiday Park, 1 Reserve Rd, Forster NSW 2428.

Day 4: Forster to Port Macquarie

Distance: 109 Kms **Time:** 1 hour 15 minutes

- **Morning:** Head to **Port Macquarie**, make a stop at the **Koala Hospital**, where you can see rescued koalas and learn about their rehabilitation.
- Afternoon: Spend the afternoon exploring **Town Beach**, a beautiful and family-friendly beach perfect for relaxing or building sandcastles.
- **Evening:** Cook a great meal in the comfort of your Cruisin' Motorhome, play some cards and unwind, getting ready for your next day of adventures!
- Where to stay: NRMA Port Macquarie Breakwall Holiday Park, 3 Munster St, Port Macquarie NSW 2444.

Day 5: Port Macquarie

Distance: 0 Kms Time: 0 hours

- Morning: Kick off the day with a visit to Lighthouse Beach for an unforgettable camel ride along the sand. The gentle camels are great with kids, and it's a truly unique experience that will leave lasting memories for the whole family!
- Afternoon: Head to Hydro Golf & Putt-Putt for a few rounds of mini golf by the river. Alternatively, enjoy the Coastal Walk, with many scenic views, especially at sunset.
- Evening: Wander to the Christmas Fair, buy local gifts, grab dinner from the food trucks and settle on a blanket to enjoy Christmas carols and entertainment on stage!

Day 6: Port Macquarie to South West Rocks

Distance: 80.9 Kms Time: 1 hour

- Morning: Pack up and head toward South West Rocks. Stop by the scenic Smoky Cape Lighthouse

 one of the oldest and tallest lighthouses in New South Wales.
- Afternoon: After lunch, walk the Monument Hill Track, featuring stunning coastal views, the easy Monument Hill walk takes in the historic monument built for German gaol internees.
- Evening: Settle in your campsite, freshen up and enjoy a 25-minute walk to The Rocks Restaurant & Bar. Appreciate a nice dinner, offering coastal views and a variety of delicious dishes.
- Where to stay: NRMA South West Rocks Holiday Park, 161 Phillip Dr, South West Rocks NSW 2431.

Day 7: South West Rocks to Coffs Harbour

Distance: 104 Kms Time: 1 hour 15 minutes

- Morning: Depart for Coffs Harbour. The first stop should be The Big Banana, an iconic roadside attraction that's home to a fun amusement park.
- Afternoon: Explore The Big Banana Fun Park more fully, including a fun tour to see how bananas are grown and harvested. Then head to the most festive event in Coffs Harbour, the Coffs Central Christmas Festival (starts December 7, 2024).
- **Evening:** Head to **Latitude 30**, a popular restaurant by the marina known for its seafood, views of the water, and sunset colours over the ocean.
- Where to stay: BIG4 Park Beach Holiday Park, 1 Ocean Parade, Coffs Harbour NSW 2450.

Day 8: Coffs Harbour to Yamba

Distance: 134 Kms Time: 1 hour 35 minutes

- Morning: Head north to Yamba, a coastal gem. Upon arrival, head to Angourie Pools, a natural wonder where you can explore rock pools and swim in clear, calm waters!
- Afternoon: Embark on a kayaking escape from life on land! Explore the middle wall, islands and bays of the Clarence River. Encounter dolphins and bird life as you paddle leisurely along!
- Evening: Head to your campsite and unwind for the day. Appreciate a homemade dinner in the luxurious kitchen of your Cruisin' Motorhome followed by a relaxing evening.
- Where to stay: NRMA Blue Dolphin Yamba Holiday Resort, Yamba Rd, Yamba NSW 2464.

Day 9: Yamba to Byron Bay

Distance: 125 Kms Time: 1 hour 25 minutes

- **Morning:** Head towards Byron Bay, stopping en route at the **Byron Bay Wildlife Sanctuary**.
- Afternoon: Head up to the Cape Byron Lighthouse, where you can walk along the clifftop trail to Australia's easternmost point and spot dolphins or whales.

- Where to stay: First Sun Holiday Park, Lawson St, Byron Bay NSW 2481.

* Day 10: Christmas Eve in Byron Bay

Distance: 0 Kms Time: 0 hours

- Morning: Book a family-friendly surf lesson for the morning. Byron Bay is famous for its surf culture, and local surf schools cater to all ages, making it a fun holiday activity for kids and parents alike.
